Interpretation 070

of

AC75 Class Rule Version 1.23 issued 29th December 2020

Rule References:

28.2 Crewmembers shall be weighed 2 or 3 days prior to racing at each Event or Event stage, dressed only in light underwear, on a schedule specified by the **Measurement Committee**. The **Measurement Committee** will use those recorded weights for verification of compliance until the next specified crew weighing date, at which point those recorded weights shall be updated. When racing, the total of the recorded crew weights corresponding to the crewmembers onboard for that race shall be within the range specified in Rule 10.1.

Questions:

1. Does rule 28.2 require that Crewmembers shall only be weighed 2 or 3 days prior to racing at each Event or Event stage?
2. Does rule 28.2 prohibit the **Measurement Committee** from specifying crew weighing dates in addition to those required to be completed 2 or 3 days prior to racing at each Event or Event stage?
3. Does rule 28.2 place any limits on the timing of crew weighing dates other than those required to be completed 2 or 3 days prior to racing at each Event or Event stage?
4. Does rule 28.2 prohibit the **Measurement Committee** specifying a crew weighing date on Thursday March 11 being approximately midway through the Match provided crewmembers have been weighed 2 or 3 days prior to the start of the Match?

Answers:

1. No, however, the **Measurement Committee** may only weigh crewmembers on specified crew weighing dates.
